Fall/Spring Youth Outdoors Crew Member

This afterschool program pays members an hourly wage and is for Saint Paul, Ramsey County, Dakota County and Minneapolis teens. Crew Members meet at Rec Centers in their neighborhoods on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays for 12 hours per week to explore science and the environment and conduct projects. Youth also participate in college visits and have opportunities to meet professionals in the environmental field.

Summer Youth Corps Crew Member

Summer Youth Corps Crew Members work in crews of seven youth and two leaders and are based at St. Croix State Park in Minnesota. This summer residential program pays \$250 weekly for four weeks, mid-June to mid-July or mid-July to mid-August. Members work to restore natural areas by maintaining hiking trails, building boardwalk, planting trees, developing campsites and removing invasive plants. Crews camp in tents and prepare their own meals. Weekends and evenings are filled with recreational activities such as canoeing, fishing, games, relaxing and visiting historic places.
