Available Positions: GS-3 Trails Ranger (\$13.45/hr), GS-4 Trails Ranger (\$15.10/hr), GS-5 Trails Ranger (\$16.90/hr), GS-6 Trails Ranger (\$18.84/hr) – **Temporary Seasonal Full-Time 1039 Appointments.** Backcountry Per Diem- \$39.05/day.

Duty Station: South Zone, Shoshone National Forest- **Lander**, Wyoming (Washakie and Wind River Ranger Districts)

Field Season: Standard field season **Early May to Early October**- earlier and later work available dependent upon position, skill set, and budget (shortened season available for fall 2022 College Students). **6 month appointments maximized.**

Work Schedule: **May-June**- Five x 8-hour days, Monday through Friday, trainings and certifications (**weekends off**).

July-Oct:

Frontcountry- Four x 10-hour day hitches, Tuesday through Friday (**4 days on, 3 days off**).

Backcountry- Eight x 10-hour day hitches, Tuesday through Tuesday (**8 days on, 6 days off**).

Overtime opportunities available.

Duties: Trail clearing and brushing (log-out), trail tread maintenance/construction (back slope, outslope, drainage, rock removal, microblasting), trail structure building (turnpikes, puncheons, retaining walls, bridges, signage), rigging, blasting, horse/mule packing, mechanized trail building, campsite clean-up, visitor contacts, outfitter/guide inspections, and hunter patrol.

2022 Program of Work: Willow Creek Ski Trails (mechanized), North Country Climbing Trail (new-mechanized), Sheep Bridge Trail realignment, Bears Ears Trail blasting, Ink Wells Slabs realignment, Downs Fork Trail puncheon, Yellowstone Trail bridge abutment installation, Continental Divide Trail bridge installation (new-mechanized).
