

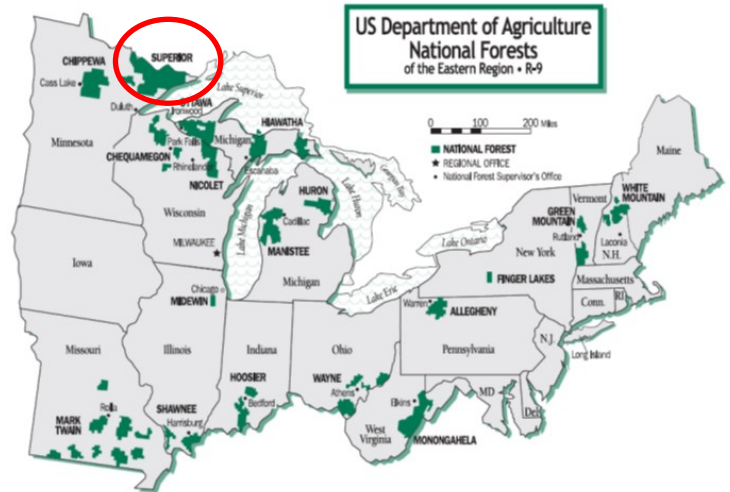


The **Superior National Forest** is seeking qualified applicants to fill multiple temporary, full-time positions for the **2022** summer season. To apply for any of these positions, visit [www.USAJOBS.gov](http://www.USAJOBS.gov)

Vacancy announcements will be posted to USAJOBS around **November 5, 2021** and will remain open for **8 days**. Start date, length of season, and number of positions hired will depend upon budget & individual unit needs. *Seasonal housing may be available in some locations.*

- **Biological Science Technician (Wildlife)** – Help protect and conserve wildlife by assessing animal populations, restoring and monitoring habitat, and evaluating projects for their effect on native species. **(Grand Marais and Tofte)**
- **Biological Science Technician (Plants)** – Help protect and conserve trees, forbs, grasses and other plants by conducting surveys, inventorying threatened and endangered plant species, and collecting and planting seeds. **(Aurora and Grand Marais)**
- **Customer Service Representative** – Work closely with forest visitors and teach them about leave-no-trace camping skills as you issue permits for the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. **(All Ranger District Offices)**
- **Forestry Technician (Heritage Resources)** - Help the forest identify and catalog pieces of history from the Superior National Forest! **(Duluth location only)**
- **Forestry Technician (Recreation & Wilderness)** – Provide visitors with safe access to a variety of recreational opportunities by maintaining, repairing and monitoring recreation sites, trails and campgrounds or serve a Back country “Wilderness Ranger” and spend up to 8 nights a pay period camping in the BWCAW doing campsite maintenance & rehabilitation. **(All Ranger District Offices)**
- **Forestry Technician (Timber & Silviculture)** – Help manage and conserve our national forests by evaluating forest conditions and collecting data, planting and pruning trees, and assisting with timber sales. **(All Ranger District Offices)**
- **Park Ranger**—Work as a Naturalist and present various wildlife and nature programs at campgrounds or resorts on the North Shore of Lake Superior. **(Tofte only)**
